

Terms of Membership



- If a skater passes into the next level of ice time before January 1, 2012, they will be required to pay the difference of cost in the different skill level.
- If a skater chooses not to skate any longer before the end of the fourth week, the registration money will be refunded.
Please NOTE: The administration fee **WILL NOT** be refunded

NSF Cheques will be subject to \$25.00 charge.

Child Fitness Tax Credits will be issued for all registrations (16 and under) at the end of the year, in time for you to include with your tax return.

DANCE LESSONS: Up to two lessons will be allowed with Dance Partner on Saturdays for **Associate Members** unless there is open lesson time available.

Skate Canada Lottery Book:

- Post-dated cheque for \$40 dated December 31, 2011
- December 31 your cheque will be cashed, so any money collected from the lottery tickets you sell, you keep.
- A \$300.00 per family post-dated cheque will be retained by the Club, until August 31, 2012. It will be returned when all fundraising requirements are met. If the following fundraising requirements are not met, than the \$ 300.00 cheque **WILL BE** cashed.
(NOTE: If only ½ your fundraising is completed, your cheque will be cashed – ALL fundraising requirements must be completed)
Time frame for fundraising completion is between Sept. 1, 2011 and August 31, 2012.

Requirements are as follows: **Meals:** 2 Meals per child (max. 4 meals) **plus** 1 Bingo

January Registrant Fundraising Requirements:

(\$150.00 post-dated cheque dated August 31st of current year)

Meals: 1 Meal per Child (max. 2 meals) plus one bingo
